Year R

- The level of pupils attaining GLD (Good Level of Development) in 2018 is higher than 2017 and also higher than LA and National levels. All 17 strands are also significantly higher, apart from Communication and Language and PSE. This was largely cohort specific.
- 100% of the 3 Pupil Premium children achieved GLD.
- The target for GLD in 2019 is 88% (with a minimum expectation of 84%)

Phonics Screening

The results of the phonics screening test this year were lower than previous years, although 98% of pupils made expected progress or above.

Only 74% achieved the required standard score of 32/40, but this is comparable with the fact that only 75% achieved expected levels in reading in the EYFS (compared to 81% achieved by the average LA school).

75% (3 out of 4) pupil premium children achieved the required standard.

After re-takes, 96% of the Year 2 cohort has now achieved the required standard. The 2 pupils below target are being supported on the phonics programme in Year 3 and receiving spelling and language support. 100% of pupil premium children in Year 2 have now reached the required level.

The percentage of pupils who were assessed as working at the expected level or above in reading is significantly above National and local expectations.

Writing at the expected level is above national and LA figures, but the percentage of pupils working at greater depth is broadly in line or just below comparative data.

Maths results were only just above National at expected levels and below National at greater depth. Attainment in maths at KS1 was a priority focus of the SIP for 2017/18. Pupils working at expected levels is now well above national data and the percentage of pupils working at greater depth increased from 13% in 2017 to 29% in 2018.

The percentage of pupils working at expected levels or above is consistently higher than LA and National standards in reading and maths. 100% of pupil premium children attained expected levels in reading and maths and 50% achieved expected levels in writing. Although writing was lower than national and LA at both expected and exceeding, the results were comparable with the KS1 writing results of the same cohort (73% at level 2b and 18% level 3)
